# The Process

Shred360 prides itself on its exceptional service and its courteous & professional employees.

Client places discarded document to be destroyed into secure collection container where it is kept secured until container is serviced.

Truck is emptied at recycler when full. Shredded paper is baled and shipped to paper manufacturer where it is made into new paper products.



CSR transfers contents of container to secure rollcart (if Rollcart, then it is taken directly to truck for Step 3).

CSR attaches rollcart to lift mechanism on mobile shred truck which lifts and empties contents directly into on-board shredder.

Documents securely destroyed on-site via on-board shredder. CSR and client may view secure destruction of documents via camera system.
